Six-a-side Football: Competition Rules

10am – Thursday 19th August 2010

Team Requirements

- A squad shall consist of 8 players, 6 playing at any one time, 1 of whom shall be the goalkeeper.
- Substitutes shall be on a rolling basis, with permission from the referee.

Eligibility

Players must be within their relevant age group – **please note the date of your age group!**

Timetable:

10am – Registration.

10.45am – Players briefing.

11am – Kick off: round robin tournament

- Round robin format.
- Length of matches will depend upon the number of teams in each group.
- Teams not ready for the start of their games will forfeit the points for that game.
- Points shall be awarded in the round robin stage as follows:
3 points for a win 1 point for a draw
- If 2 teams are tied on points then the highest scoring team will progress, if this is the same then the best goal difference will go through. If this is still equal then a penalty shoot out will take place with 3 penalties for each team.

3pm – Finals stage

- In the event of a draw in the final stage, the match will be decided by penalty kicks. Three penalties per team followed by one penalty per team alternately until a result is achieved

3.30pm – Tournament closes



Match Rules:

- **EVERY PLAYER MUST WEAR SHIN PADS & REMOVE JEWELLERY.**
Players without shin pads will not be allowed to play in the games.
- **No blades, studs, or molded soles** are allowed on the Astroturf.
Referees will inspect footwear. Only Astroturf or normal trainers are permitted.
- **NO FOUL OR OBUSIVE LANGUAGE FROM PLAYERS, MANAGERS OR SUPPORTERS.** Referees and tournament organisers have the right to eject any player, manager or supporter if he/she is deemed to be in breach of this rule.
- Immediate changeover between games.
- Rolling Substitutes – when ball is out of play.
- Normal Throw ins.
- Normal Corners.
- **NO** Offside.
- Over head height **ALLOWED**.
- Goalkeepers can only **THROW** the Ball otherwise Free kick on the edge of area.
- Goalkeepers can save the ball with their feet from an opponents shot, and may treat a through ball from the opposition as a shot.
- **No** Sliding Tackles.
- All Free Kicks Direct.
- Defending players 3 metres away at Free Kicks.
- Goalkeepers **MUST** stay in area (penalty awarded).
- Outfield players from both sides **MAY** go into the area.
- Officials may sin bin a player for 1 minute if they feel they need to 'cool off'.
- Any player receiving a yellow card will automatically miss the next game.
- Any player receiving a red card will be suspended from the tournament and will take no further part. The player will also be banned from the following tournament.
- Blue Card – offensive language. One warning and then if shown again 2 minutes in the sin bin.
- **Officials' decision is final.**



Parents and Supporters:

We welcome your attendance at the event and have some guidelines that we request you follow for the benefit of the young people playing.

- Parents and spectators should be reminded to applaud the opposition as well as your own team.
- Avoid coaching during the game.
- Don't shout and scream at young people but give positive encouragement to everyone participating in the tournament.
- Please stay within the marked areas for spectators and do not go on the pitch during the matches.
- Young people look to you as roles models so please set a positive example for them to follow.

Our venue, Tattenhoe Pavilion, has some rules that we must follow: -

These rules are posted near to the entry to the Astroturf. Please ensure your players and supporters read and adhere to these rules.

Of particular note:

- No blades, studs, or moulded soles are allowed on the Astroturf. Referees will inspect footwear. Only Astroturf or normal trainers are permitted.
- All consumption of food must be made outside the Astroturf area.
- Teams are requested to ensure no rubbish is left on the Astroturf. Plastic bags will be provided for this.
- Toilet facilities are available in the Pavilion building.
- If goals are broken or damaged during the event then the teams responsible will pay for the replacement of the equipment.
- **Lockers** are available for hire inside the pavilion and the tournament organisers advise that these are used where ever possible. The tournament organisers can not accept responsibility for lost or stolen property.
- The order of play and copies of the rules will be available at the event.
- Please remember this event is not aimed at existing clubs that regularly play competitive football, but is for young people who wish to play football with their friends in a safe and friendly environment. The emphasis is on fun and enjoyment, and good sportsmanship is to be promoted at all times.
- Places are limited in each age group, so to be sure of your entry please book as soon as possible.

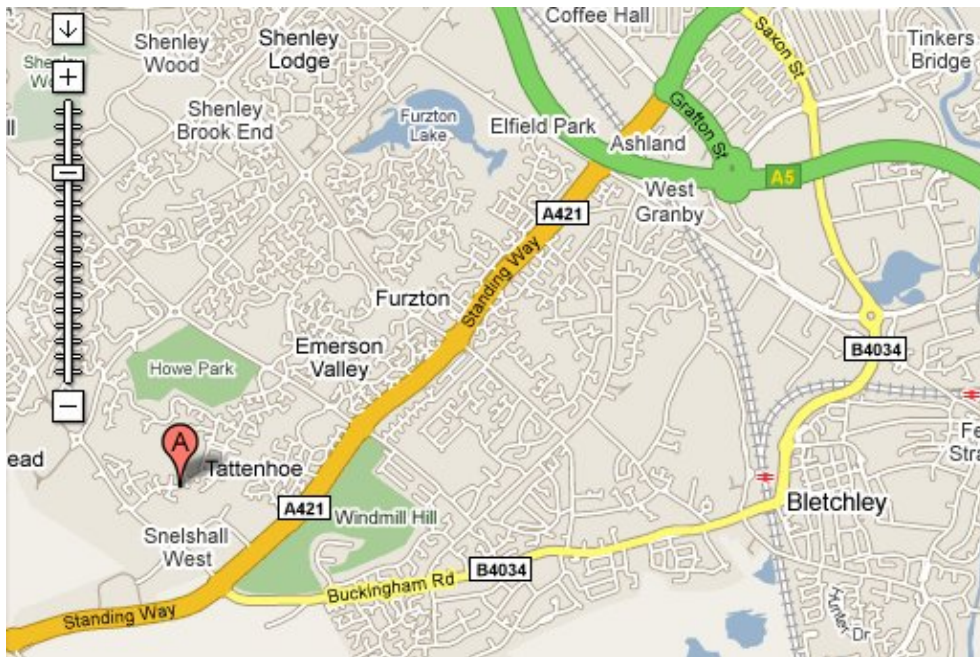
